# CITY OF GREENFIELD PARKS COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES February 26, 2025

The Parks Commission met in regular session on Wednesday February 26, 2025 at 5:30 p.m. in the council chambers at 7738 Commerce Circle.

## 1. Call to Order

Vice Chair Mastel called the February 26, 2025, meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

## 2. Roll Call

Members Present: Brian Mastel, Ben Lindaman, Anne Wittnebel. Absent Jared Anderson Others present: City Administrator Margaret Webb, Administrative Assistant Jackie Riebel, Nat Schmidt from RAAA

**3. Appoint Chair and Vice Chair** Wittnebel nominated Brian Mastel as Chair, Lindaman seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0. Mastel nominated Ann Wittnebel as Vice Chair. Lindaman seconded motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0

#### 4. Approval of Agenda

Motion by Lindaman, seconded by Wittnebel to approve the agenda. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0.

#### 5. Approval of Minutes of September 24, 2024

MOTION by Wittnebel, seconded by Lindaman to approve the minutes of September 24, 2024. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0.

**6. Approval of 2025 Calendar -** Staff Webb reminded council of spring break last year we had to cancel meeting and questioned whether we should keep March 26 meeting or change to March 19. Lindaman made a motion to amend March 26<sup>th</sup> meeting to March 19<sup>th</sup>. Wittnebel seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried 3-0.

7. Kevin Clark from Hoisington – grand funds from MN Twins, suggestions of moving forward with ballfield project and future grants. Kevin handed out cost estimates, sketches of Greenfield Central Park and what funding could look like. Nat Schmidt from RAAA let us know that there are 200-220 players registered this year. They would like to contribute \$80,000 - \$85,000 towards the new field and they are continuing to fundraise for amenities for after the park is built for.
